

Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007.

No. GH/SH/36/2022/PVS/102020/474/S ::- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 20 read with section 4 of the Gujarat Professional Technical Educational Colleges or Institutions (Regulation of Admission and Fixation of Fees) Act, 2007 (Guj. 2 of 2008), the Government of Gujarat hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Bachelor of Planning (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) Rules, 2020, namely:-

- 1. (1) These rules may be called the Bachelor of Planning (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) (Amendment) Rules, 2022.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. In the Bachelor of Planning (Regulation of Admission and Payment of Fees) 2020, for rule 19, the following rule shall be substituted namely:

"19. Vacant seats.-

- (1) The vacant seats of Government and aided Colleges / Institutions shall be filled by the Admission Committee through online/offline counselling in the following order, namely: -
 - (i) the names of the candidates whose names appear in the merit list of the Admission Committee;
- above if seats rouse: such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have orescribed in rule 5 and appeared in JEE (Main)/ GUJCET and appeared in JEE (Main)/ GUJCET current year online/offline admission process. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the prevailing rule and guideline of Admission Committee.
 - (iii) after allotting the seats to the candidates mentioned in clauses (i) and (ii) above, if seats remain vacant, the Admission Committee

shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria in supplementary examination with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 and appeared in JEE (Main)/GUJCET examination of corresponding year. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the prevailing rule and guideline of Admission Committee.

- (iv) after allotting the seats to the candidates mentioned in clauses (i), (ii) and (iii) above, if seats remain vacant, the Admission Committee shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 and who have passed the qualifying examination from outside the Gujarat State and have appeared in JEE (Main)/ GUJCET conducted in the corresponding academic year, giving priority to the candidates of Gujarat origin. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the prevailing rule and guideline of Admission Committee.
- (v) after allotting the seats to candidates mentioned in clauses (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) above, if seats remain vacant, the Admission Committee shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination from India (Including Gujarat) with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 but not appeared in JEE (Main) /GUJCET or any entrance examination, shall be eligible for admission. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of percentile marks obtained in theory subjects of qualifying examination.
- (2) After offering admission to all the candidates whose names appear in the merit list or after completion of the online/offline admission process, if un-aided college or institution seats remain vacant, such vacant seats shall be filled by the un-aided college or institution as per the directions issued by the Admission Committee.

The Admission Committee shall, by an advertisement in the prominent newspapers widely circulated in the State, by website and by such other means, as it may consider convenient, display the details of vacant seats and Schedule for vacant seats admission on its website. The

candidates who are already having the merit number of the Admission Committee shall have to submit copy of his registration form to participate for the vacant seats round. Whereas, the eligible candidates who have not registered earlier shall have to apply at the institute level as per the Schedule declared by the Admission Committee.

All eligible/meritorious candidates shall have to approach to self-financed institutes of his choice for admission in vacant seats. An acknowledgement shall be given to candidate by concerned self-financed institutions. The concerned self-financed institutions shall process the filling up of vacant seats among such eligible candidates who have submitted registration form by preparing common intra-se merit list in the following order and guidelines issued by the Admission Committee from time to time:

- (i) The names of the candidates whose names appear in the merit list of the Admission Committee;
- (ii) after allotting the seats to the candidates mentioned in clause (i) above, if seats remain vacant, the un-aided colleges or institutions shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 and appeared in JEE (Main)/ GUJCET examination of corresponding year but have not registered in current year online/offline admission process. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the prevailing rule and guideline of Admission Committee.
- (iii) After allotting the seats to the candidates mentioned in clauses (i) and (ii) above, if seats remain vacant, the un-aided colleges or institutions shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria in supplementary examination and appeared in JEE (Main)/ GUJCET examination of corresponding year. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the prevailing rule and guideline of Admission Committee.
- (iv) after allotting the seats to the candidates mentioned in clauses (i), (ii) and (iii) above, if seats remain vacant, the un-aided colleges or institutions shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 and who have passed the qualifying examination from outside the Gujarat State and have appeared in JEE (Main)/

GUJCET conducted in the corresponding academic year, giving priority to the candidates of Gujarat origin. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of the prevailing rule and guideline of Admission Committee.

(v) after allotting the seats to candidates mentioned in clauses (i), (ii), (iii) and (iv) above, if seats remain vacant, the un-aided colleges or institutions shall fill such seats by inviting the application from the candidates who have cleared the qualifying examination from India (Including Qujarat) with minimum eligibility criteria prescribed in rule 5 but not appeared in JEE (Main) /GUJCET or any entrance examination, shall be eligible for admission. The merit list shall be prepared on the basis of percentile marks obtained in theory subjects of qualifying examination.
