

IMPORTANT NOTICE FOR B.ARCH. ADMISSION ACADEMIC YEAR 2025-2026 REGARDING ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA AND DISTRIBUTION OF SEATS



Eligibility Criteria:

As per B. Arch Notification by Education Department, Government of Gujarat dated 15.06.2024: A candidate shall have passed the Qualifying Examination with minimum eligibility criteria as prescribed by Council of Architecture (CoA) time to time, currently as per amendment in eligibility criteria by Council of Architecture (CoA) dated 08.07.2024 stated as below,

"No candidate shall be admitted to architecture course unless she/he has passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Physics and Mathematics as compulsory subjects along with either Chemistry or Biology or Technical Vocational subject or Computer Science or Information Technology or Informatics Practices or Engineering Graphics or Business Studies with at least 45% (40% for SC, ST, SEBC and EWS candidates) marks in aggregate or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 45% (40% for SC, ST, SEBC and EWS candidates) marks in aggregate.

and

have qualified an aptitude test in architecture with valid score conducted either by NTA (i.e. JEE) or "NATA" conducted by the Council of Architecture for corresponding academic year."

Distribution of Government Seats:

As per B. Arch Notification by Education Department, Government of Gujarat dated 15.06.2024: For the admission year 2025-26, the Government Seats which includes,

- All sanctioned seats of Government and Grant in-Aid Colleges,
- 33% seats of sanctioned intake and surrendered seats of Management Quota of Centre of Excellence (CoE) Universities/Colleges of Gujarat and
- 50% seats of sanctioned intake and surrendered seats of Management quota of unaided Colleges of Gujarat

Further, such seats shall be distributed as:

- a) 95% seats of Government and Government Aided Institutes shall be available for the candidates who have cleared the Qualifying Examination with minimum eligibility criteria from an eligible board from the schools located in Gujarat State.
- b) 5% Government and Government Aided Institutes shall be available for the candidates who have cleared the Qualifying Examination with minimum eligibility criteria from an eligible board from the schools located in India (Including Gujarat State)
- c) The seats (mentioned in (a) and (b)) shall be distributed pro-rata basis between eligible candidates who have applied to ACPC and appeared in JEE and NATA examination of corresponding year.
