The PGETA 2025 will be held on the following dates:

- 4th May 2025 (Sunday)
- 25th May 2025 (Sunday)
- 15th June 2025 (Sunday)

The entrance test will be conducted in the form of a Computer-Based Test (CBT) at designated centres across the country. Each test will be held from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM, with a duration of two hours. Candidates may appear for a maximum of three attempts in PGETA 2025. The PGETA 2025 information brochure is available on the websites: Council of Architecture: www.coa.gov.in and PGETA Portal: www.pgeta.in. Candidates and institutions are advised to refer to the official websites for updates and further instructions.

All the institutions approved by the Council for imparting B.Arch. and/or M.Arch. degree programme in the country are therefore requested to bring this to the notice of the students currently pursuing Final year B.Arch. course enabling them to appear for PGETA 2025 for admission into Post Graduate programme in Architecture and also ensure that candidates are admitted into 1st year of PG programme being imparted by them for the academic session 2025-2026, based on the PGETA conducted by the COA.

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In case the centralised admission process for PG programme in Architecture has commenced in any State/UT, the concerned admission authority may process the admissions in the programme as per their respective processes and/or may also fill up seats on the basis of the PG Test conducted by the Council.

In light of the above, all institutions, universities, and admission authorities are kindly requested to take note of the Post Graduate Entrance Test in Architecture (PGETA) being conducted by the Council for admissions to postgraduate architecture programmes for the academic session 2025–2026, and to take appropriate action accordingly at their end.
